1. The Loss of Relationship

When sin entered in it affected all our relationships. Man with God, and man with man. Genesis 4:9 Am I my brother's keeper?"

Quoted in N.T. more than any other verse.

Gal. 5:14 The whole law... Luke 10:29 "Who is my neighbor?"

Heb. 10:24-25

- a) Exhorting spurring on
- b) Encouraging coming alongside

So what can we do?



Five Fellowship "muscles" to work on:

- 1. **Serving** home, church, reaching out. Don't spend everything on yourself. Don't mope around saying no one loves me.
- 2. **Listening** Learn to give the gift of yourself. Ask better questions.
- 3. **Learning** open to reproof, reading, listening to messages Prov.27:5-6 Better is open rebuke than love that is concealed. Faithful are the wounds of a friend, but deceitful are the kisses of an enemy.
 - 4. **Forgiving** This is key. Many will hurt you and let you down. You must get over it.

5. Initiating

We tend to get worse, not better, as we age. Talk too much, complaining, putting people under pressure, not listening, critical spirit, defensive. Grow now!

Make God your best friend. Otherwise you will tend to smother people.
